

Pet Rehoming Services and Assistance

Please understand that when a shelter is unable to take your pet in, it is not because the staff does not care. The local shelters and rescues in our area are doing their best to keep up with the constant increase of pet overpopulation. What other options are there besides owner surrender?

• Petfinder.com or Adopt-A-Pet.com:

- O If your pet is spayed/neutered we can host them on our page of Petfinder.com. When anyone is searching their local area for adoptable pets, your pet will be listed for them to see too. We need some photos of your pet, a description of the pet's personality, their age, what kind of home they would do best in, and a good way for interested adopters to contact you. The adoption process all goes through you, so you can decide requirements, adoption fee, and any other stipulations in the rehoming of your pet.
